As of 23 April 2023, Mr. Gabriel Andronache is Vice President of the Romanian Energy Regulatory Authority.

From December 2021 to April 2023, he held the position of Chairman of the Board of Directors of Romanian Power Grid Company Transelectrica S.A.

Mr. Gabriel Andronache holds an extensive managerial experience in the administrative, public and private sectors as well as in the energy industry. Mr. Andronache has also served on the stock exchange listing committees for strategic companies in Romanian energy sector, such as Transgaz, Nuclearelectrica and Romgaz. His expertise in the energy industry is also reflected in his work on the supervisory boards of several companies in the electricity value chain.



Mr. Andronache was a member of the Board of Directors of Electrica S.A. (2013), a member of the Board of Directors of ENEL Distribution Banat S.A. (2014-2015), a member of the Supervisory Board of Hidroelectrica S.A. Bucharest (2017-2019).

Mr. Gabriel Andronache has consolidated his experience through various key positions in the central public administration: director of the cabinet of the Minister of Economy, Trade and Business Environment (2014-2015), advisor at the Office for Trade and Economic Promotion, Romanian Embassy in Paris (2015-2017), president of the Interministerial Council for the implementation of state aid policy at the Romanian Government (2017-2018). He also served as a State Counsellor in the Prime Minister's Office from 2017 to 2018.

Mr. Andronache graduated "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" Police Academy in Bucharest with a degree in legal sciences, followed by postgraduate studies in Public Law and Administrative Sciences at the Faculty of Law of the University of Bucharest, as well as a course on Security and Good Governance at the National Defence College (2014).
